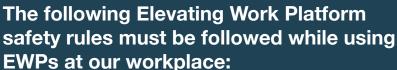
## ELEVATING WORK PLATFORM SAFETY RULES





- 1. Only trained and authorized persons are allowed to operate our lifting equipment.
- 2. Always assess the area you will be working in for safety hazards.
- 3. Look for any overhead hazards such as fans, electrical wires etc.
- 4. Always inspect the EWP and your Fall Protection equipment before using.
- 5. Use 3-points of contact when getting in and out.
- 6. Know the capacity of the EWP and ensure that loads are distributed evenly on the platform.
- 7. Only operate the EWP on firm level surfaces and travel slowly on bumpy or sloped areas.
- 8. No standing on the railings or use of ladders is permitted.
- 9. Always be aware of other traffic, pedestrians or other things that move around or change around you when using EWPs.
- 10. Use a spotter or barricades to prevent people or equipment from hitting your unit when being used.
- 11. Refrain from operating in the raised position.
- 12. Ensure you know how to lower the equipment in the event of a power failure, this includes having to explain it to those on the ground how to lower the unit.
- 13. Always warn others when driving through doorways or around corners.
- 14. Have a rescue plan just in case something happens to you.
